Approve Meeting Minutes

Mr. Johnson presented the forecasted water supply needs, wastewater flows, water residuals, and wastewater biosolids generation for planning horizon.

Mr. Johnson presented an overview of the draft Appendix B – County Summaries tables.

Mr. Andrew Morris and Ms. Celine Benoit presented an overview of changes to the water supply and water conservation action items.

Mr. Morris presented the benefit-cost analysis conducted for the proposed changes to selected water supply and water conservation action items.

Mr. Johnson presented a list of action items proposed for elimination.

Mr. Johnson presented the regional septic system flow forecasts and the staff recommendation that the metro Atlanta plumbing code efficiency requirements be adopted to reduce future flows to septic tanks.

Ms. Katherine Atteberry presented an overview of the stormwater forecast and a staff recommendation that the District fund up to \$100,000 from available funding in the Water
