Corey Babb of the Metro Water District staff opened the meeting, initiated introductions and reviewed the meeting agenda with the group.

Public Comment Period

There were no public comments.

Written Procedures for Preventing the Discharge of Grease

Nate Giddens, Industrial Pretreatment Coordinator for Cherokee County Water and Sewerage Authority provided an overview of the Authority's grease control program. This included a review of the program's development and history, program administration, implementation challenges, positive impacts and future plans. A question and answer session was held after the presentation for TCC members.

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Inspection Program for Grease Haulers

Ernest Earn with Cobb County Water System provided an update on the State's regulatory requirements for commercial grease haulers. This update included an overview of the original legislation, the GA EPD's commercial waste rule and commercial hauler inspection requirements in the Metro Water District Plan and GA EPD audit checklist. There were no questions following the presentation.

Annetta Diew with Fulton County presented an overview of the County's commercial waste transporter vehicles inspection and permitting program. This included an overview of the inspection procedure, forms associated with inspection, reporting and permitting and the various commercial hauler vehicle types. A question and answer session was held after the presentation for TCC members. One TCC member asked how the inspections should be documented for Metro Water District plan requirement and GA EPD auditing purposes. A TCC member who had recently undergone the GA EPD audit informed the committee members that an email exchange between jurisdictions delegating inspection authority would suffice as proper documentation for the purposes of the audit.

DRAFT FOG Education Brochure for Food Service Establishments (FSE's)

Corey Babb provided an overview of the DRAFT FOG Education Brochure for FSE's. This consisted of a brief review of changes made to the brochure based on comments received from the Education and Wastewater TCC's. Mr. Babb informed the TCC members that the brochures would be ready for distribution once a final review was made by the Stormwater TCC members.

Other

Corey Babb addressed three additional items which were not included in the Meeting Agenda. These included: a potential change to the FOG Education Brochure, to whom the local jurisdictions should send their private decentralized wastewater systems ordinance and the release of GA EPD's supporting documentation for the Lake Allatoona Modeling Scenarios.

The meeting was adjourned.
