Public Comment

There were no public comments.

Water Drop Dash 5K and Water Festival

Lora Amedu discussed the final details for the race and presented the race postcard. District members were asked to participate and promote the race in their community.

Fix a Leak Week

Ms. Vallianos discussed the upcoming Fix a Leak Week scheduled for March 17-23, 2014. Material for the national awareness event was included in the meeting materials. They include EPA WaterSense logos, press release, timelines, postcards, bill inserts, factsheets and children's material. District members were encouraged to use the material to promote Fix a Leak Week. Requests for additional materials are to go to Ms. Vallianos.

Review Material

Ms. Vallianos presented a new Clean Water Campaign TV slide. The message of this slide was "Wipes Clog Pipes". There were no further comments. Ms. Vallianos also provided an update on other previously reviewed material.

Fog Clogs Video Contest

Ms. Vallianos reminded education partners that the FOG Clogs! High School Video Contest deadline is February 28, 2014. Judging will take place the first week of March. Cobb County, City of Roswell, Gwinnett County and Paulding County representatives volunteered to judge the video submissions. Winners will be notified March 7, 2014. Winners will be honored at the Water Drop Dash 5K at the Chattahoochee Nature Center.

Metro Water District Plan Update

Danny Johnson, provided overview of the Plan Update schedule. Mr. Johnson also led a discussion about future participation in the development of the Plan Update's visions and goals. It was agreed that the May Ed TCC would be combined with the other two TCCs.

Targeted Outreach

- Laurie Loftin with Athens-Clarke County presented on their septic maintenance program for home owners. This program focused on traditional methods of outreach such as billboard advertising and printed materials, but also inventive approaches like septic pumping parties and pumping prompts on promotional plungers. They used GIS mapping to identify neighborhoods with a lot of septic tanks.
- John Butler from Gwinnett County presented the outcomes from a pilot project focused on veterinary clinics. Gwinnett County left pet waste brochures in 60 veterinary clinics across the county. Mr. Butler then went back and counted how many brochures were actually taken.

<u>Other</u>

- Ms. Vallianos provided an update on the WOW Children's Water Festival and the Southern Children's Water Festival scheduled for May 8 and May 6 respectively. Education partners are invited to volunteer at both if they aren't already involved.
- Event highlights were reviewed. Education partners were reminded to send planned event dates.
- Rain Garden Tour is scheduled for May 16, 2014. The event will start in South Fulton County, and end in Cobb County. Three rain gardens will be visited.
- Education partners were reminded that the May meeting will be a held May 21 as a joint meeting.
