Renea Hall, US EPA Region IV staff, gave a presentation on Community Based Social Marketing and the tools the EPA has created to help the education and outreach staff in their efforts.

Other

- The schedule for the Metro Water District Plan Update was reviewed. Education TCC members
 were invited to attend the joint TCC scheduled for Wednesday, August 13, to discuss the Scope
 of Work for the Plan Update;
- An overview of the 2014 Children's Water Festivals held in May at Welcome All Park in Fulton County and at the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area in Cobb County was provided. Education TCC members were encouraged to participate in 2015 festivals. Planning will begin in the fall.
- The 2014 Media Buy is underway. Several radio stations are airing My Drop Counts and Clean Water Campaign radio ads. This media buy also includes some internet remarketing which will continue for several more weeks.
- Two of the My Drop Counts video PSA's won national Telly Awards.
- The 2014 Sales Tax Holiday will be October 3-5, 2014. WaterSense and ENERGY STAR
 products are state and local sales tax free during the holiday.
- The 2015 Water Drop Dash date is scheduled for Saturday, March 21, 2015. A planning meeting will be held in September.
- The Metro Water District has a new Logo, as indicated on the meeting material.Late summer and fall event highlights were reviewed.
- The final Education TCC meeting of 2014 will be held on Wednesday, November 12, 2014.
