

RFP Questions and Answers - Race Coordination and Event Management for Trail Run and Education Fair

1. Is this going to be on an established trail?

Yes, there are established trails around the Cubihatcha Outdoor Education Center and we will use these trails to form the race route. The main trail loops around the Long Branch Reservoir and is approximately 7.5 miles. There are also approximately 3 miles of established trails that the race route could tie into for additional distance.

2. What distance will this race be?

The distance of the race will be approximately 7.5 miles on the established trail around the Long Branch Reservoir and may include the additional established trails around the outdoor education center. We do not anticipate the race to be longer than 10 miles.

3. How accessible is the trail to set-up water stations along the route?

The trail is accessible for water stations along the route. Throughout the trails there are pavilions that can be used for water stations. There are also cleared areas along the route that would accommodate water station supplies and/or portable restrooms.

4. Will we access these points by driving along the trail or from existing access points? If access points, how many are available along the route?

Access points are minimal along the trail. Water stations will mostly be accessed by driving along the trail.

5. If we are driving along the trail, what vehicles can be used to transport supplies?

There will be driving along the trail. Cubihatcha Outdoor Education Center has all-terrain vehicles that can be used for transporting supplies and for shuttling volunteers and runners from parking areas.
