



Level 2 Drought Response – Residential Fact Sheet

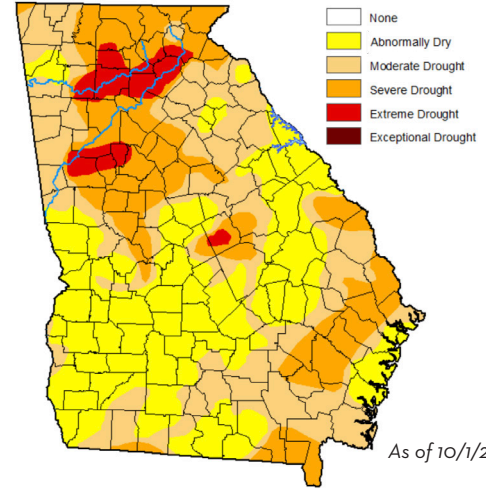

A Level 2 Drought Response has been declared for customers of Coweta County Water and Sewerage Authority.

Under a Level 2 Drought Response you are allowed to water your landscape as follows:

- Only as needed, up to **TWICE A WEEK** (even addresses and sites with no numbered address on Wednesday or Saturday and odd addresses on Thursday or Sunday)
- Only **BEFORE 10 AM** and **AFTER 4 PM**

What's NOT Allowed

- Washing streets, gutters, sidewalks and driveways
- Ornamental uses, such as fountains and waterfalls
- Washing vehicles (cars, boats, etc.) at home
- Non-commercial washing or pressure washing
- Charity, or non-commercial fund-raiser, car washes



What's Allowed*

- Irrigation of personal food gardens
- Irrigation of new and replanted seed, turf or plants for a period of 30 days following installation
- Watering with drip irrigation or soaker hose
- Hand watering, including hoses with shut-off nozzle
- Use of water withdrawn from private water wells

*Not subject to the twice a week restrictions

Water Conservation Tips

- Only water plants when necessary. More plants die from over-watering than from under-watering.
- Water the root zone of the plant instead of the foliage. This saves water and reduces diseases.
- Fix leaking toilets. This can save you hundreds of gallons a day.
- Turn off the faucet when brushing your teeth or shaving. This could save a total of 12 gallons a day.
